IDENTIFY AND ENGAGE PARTNERS

Identify organizations sponsoring or supporting Registered Apprenticeship (RA) through:

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- <u>Apprenticeship.gov</u>
- Office of Apprenticeship (OA) or State Apprenticeship Agency (SAA) Office
- Identify local community supportive services provider(s)
 Define Pre-Apprenticeship Goals:
- Participant: Describe expected successful workforce outcomes for the individual
- Program: Describe overall outcomes for all participants
- Partner: Describe engagement and outcomes important to RAP sponsor

- Align IET workforce training component with RAP On-the-Job Training (OJT) hours/competencies and Related Technical Instruction (RTI) standards as part of the IET program's Single Set of Learning Objectives (SSLO)
- Identify RA preparation activities, short-term technical, and workforce prep certificates or credentials as part of the IET workforce prep component
- With RAP sponsor, map preapprenticeship skills and competencies to RTI requirements for CPL

EMBED OJT OPPORTUNITIES

- Determine ways to incorporate parts/ foundations of RAP OJT into adult education preapprenticeship program
- Provide job shadowing, short-term hands-on training on-site through IET/preapprenticeship instruction
- Track OJT-related work experience/competencies for CPE toward RAP requirements

IMPLEMENT RAP PRE/ENROLLMENT PROCESS

- Develop direct entry agreement with RAP sponsor for pre-apprenticeship program completers
- Participants complete preapplication assessments
- Present candidates to the RAP sponsor
- Assist and coach participants
 with RAP application process
- Support sponsor with articulated CPE/CPL verification toward RAP requirements
- Connect pre-apprentices with needed supportive services for ongoing support to improve retention and completion rates
