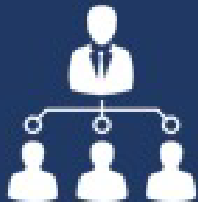
What is USDOL Registered Youth Apprenticeship?

- An industry-driven, high-quality, “earn and learn” model for in-school and out-of-school youth between the ages of 16 - 24
- Bridges the classroom and workplace
- Enables employers to engage earlier with students to prepare them for full time work
- Provides students with mentor-led, paid work-based learning resulting in a portable, national credential

Since February 2022

9 DESE/Safal Partners Bootcamp CTE/HS participants

- 54 In-High School Youth Registered
- 4 Programs Newly Registered
- 7/9 Participating Programs started or expanded

Current In High School Youth Stats Registered 2018-

- 27 high schools and CTE programs are Youth In-High School RA sponsors
- 274 registered IN HIGH SCHOOL youth apprentices
- 54 In High School Completed in 3 years
