

Number of American workers at or nearing 65 is growing rapidly while....








The Birth Rate Isn't Keeping Pace

Nature of Work is Changing

For Employers & Workers Alike

Business: Automation & Technology

- Institutionalization of remote work
- 50% of business leaders surveyed accelerating job automation post-Covid
- Most technical skills "half-life" of 2.5 years = constant need for training

Workers Reconsidering Assumptions

- Gig economy & self-employment
- Less stigma around length of stay
- Value of post-secondary degree or academic certificate & student debt





Federal & State Incentivization

Growing Visibility & Value of Apprenticeship

Federal investments

 Massive USDOL investments including Youth Apprenticeship Readiness Grants (YARGs), Youth Apprenticeship Intermediary Contracts

State investments

- In 2020 states passed 494 pieces of legislation related to apprenticeship
- Recent announcement \$65 million DAS youth apprenticeship grant program

Workforce Alignment

- 100% of 2020 2023 State Unified and Combined Plans mentioned Registered Apprenticeship as part of WIOA planning
- 84% incorporated federal grant planning to expand RA





Employer Motivation for RYA

As forces converge, employers increasingly realizing need to:

- Engage with students far earlier in their academic careers to ensure they are work-ready on Day 1
- Heighten visibility to be viewed as local employer of choice
- Have structured training plan in place to
 - help schools inform curriculum
 - more quickly shrink potential skills gap
- Use recruiting & training model that produces positive ROI and higher FTE rates (vs. internships and co-op experiences)



Tech Registered Youth Apprenticeship Program

School: North/South Tech High School (MO)

Employer: World Wide Technology (WWT)



- WWT: Fortune 100 "Top Company to Work For"
- Provides supply chain tech to nearly 50% of Fortune 500 companies
- Developed program with local high school-based Cisco Networking Academy
- Signed 5 high school students as Configuration Technicians last week; creating pipeline of HS talent
- Will result in CCNA credential, USDOL Journeyworker credential





High-Tech Youth RA Program

Junior Year

- Complete Cisco Networking Academy 1
- Secure instructor recommendation

Senior Year

- Register as youth apprentice
- Work 20 hours/week after school for 3 rotations

Graduation/

Post-Program

- Complete program
- Earn Cisco CCNA certification
- Eligible for FTE










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
